Hydroelectric Plant Operator – Okikendawt Hydroelectric Project

The Okikendawt Hydro Limited Partnership (OHLP) is a partnership formed between the Dokis First Nation and Hydromega Services Inc. to develop, build and operate a 10MW hydroelectric plant located on the French River at the outlet of Lake Nipissing.

Hydromega Services currently has two (2) openings for qualified candidates to fill the position of Hydroelectric Plant Operator. Construction is scheduled to begin in Summer 2012 with a planned Commercial Operation Date set in early 2014. However, position is expected to be effective in Fall 2012, as the successful candidates will receive an extensive training in an existing hydroelectric plant to familiarize themselves with the charges and duties specific to this position.

Under the supervision of the Director of operations, the Operators will be responsible of the day-to-day operation of the plant in order to maximise its long term energy output. They will also be responsible of the daily maintenance and surveillance of all the mechanical and electrical equipments. They will support and assist the Director of operations during the planned maintenance outages, which are usually performed by sub-contractors. Operators will apply the different directives from the authorities and are expected to be available 24hours/day during their permanence to answer and deal with any emergency call.

- Five (5) years experience in the industrial sector ;
- Computer and software skills;

The operators must leave close to the plant during their permanence. The permanence consists of an eight (8) days shift followed by a six (6) days break.
